GLIOMATCH is a European research effort working to find better and more personalised treatments for people with advanced brain cancers, especially:

- Paediatric glioma: a rare type of brain cancer that affects children.
- Adult glioblastoma: an aggressive brain tumour that is difficult to treat.

Goal: To develop more effective, personalised therapies that match each patient's unique condition.
